

Floral Sculpture Trail

Whether you're a fan of 'plants and blooms' or 'fashion and footwear' there's now a new and exciting way to discover the city centre's great shops and at the same time enjoy the wonderful new floral sculptures around the city.

Nottingham's Retailers have teamed up with Nottingham City Council to present the city's first Floral Sculpture Trail as a tribute to the city's very successful 'In Bloom' Campaign.

The eight willow sculptures have been designed and created by Topiary Art Design and the individual planting arrangements by Nottingham in Bloom. They will be in place from mid June to September. They will also form the city's entry into the East Midlands in Bloom Campaign.

Where you start and finish the trail is your choice - we estimate it will take you between 30 to 45 minutes to complete the trail in full. No special footwear is required, although flat comfortable shoes are recommended.

Most of the route is wheelchair and pushchair accessible, but please be aware that once you leave the core pedestrianised areas you may encounter steeper gradients and more changes in level.

We hope you enjoy all the city centre has to offer.

The main plants used for these bespoke sculptures are:

Jacket:	Strong and bold purples and whites with Geranium Tomboy and Dichondra Silver Falls
Perfume Bottle:	Overflowing with pink and rose vein Surfinia
Ring:	Sparkling in classic whites and silvers, with Geranium Blanc Roche and Calceolophulus Silver Falls
Dress:	loating in a bed of baby pinks and silvers - Ricinus, Cosmos, Begonia and Verbena
Shoe:	Hot and sexy with Begonia panorama Scarlet
Handbag:	Reds, whites and pinks in profusion, with ivy leafed pink Geranium, Surfinia and Bacopa
Coffee Cup:	A frothy mocha latte of ivy leafed white Geranium and Heuchera Black Beauty
Chair:	Foliage and form featuring Chlorophytum and Verbena quartz silver

8. Chair Canning Circus

7. Coffee Cup St Peters Square

If you're ready for a break try one of the city centre's tea and coffee shops. Plenty to choose from, not only dotted along the pedestrianised streets, but tucked down some of our historic side streets as well. Take a break off the beaten track!



1. Jacket King Street/Queen Street

Fashion dominates the shopping scene in the city centre, particularly close to the Square. The Exchange, Debenhams, Primark and Zara are all close by - and not just for jackets!



2. Perfume Bottle Milton Street/Victoria Centre

The Victoria Centre is home to Boots, House of Fraser, John Lewis and Next and much more. With 120 shops all under one roof and all the facilities of a major shopping centre - a visit to this scented heaven is a must!



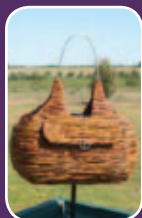
3. Ring Thurland Street

Young fashion and some of the city's leisure brands are here at the edge of Nottingham's historic Lace Market. Once home to the lace industry - fashion is today's offer.



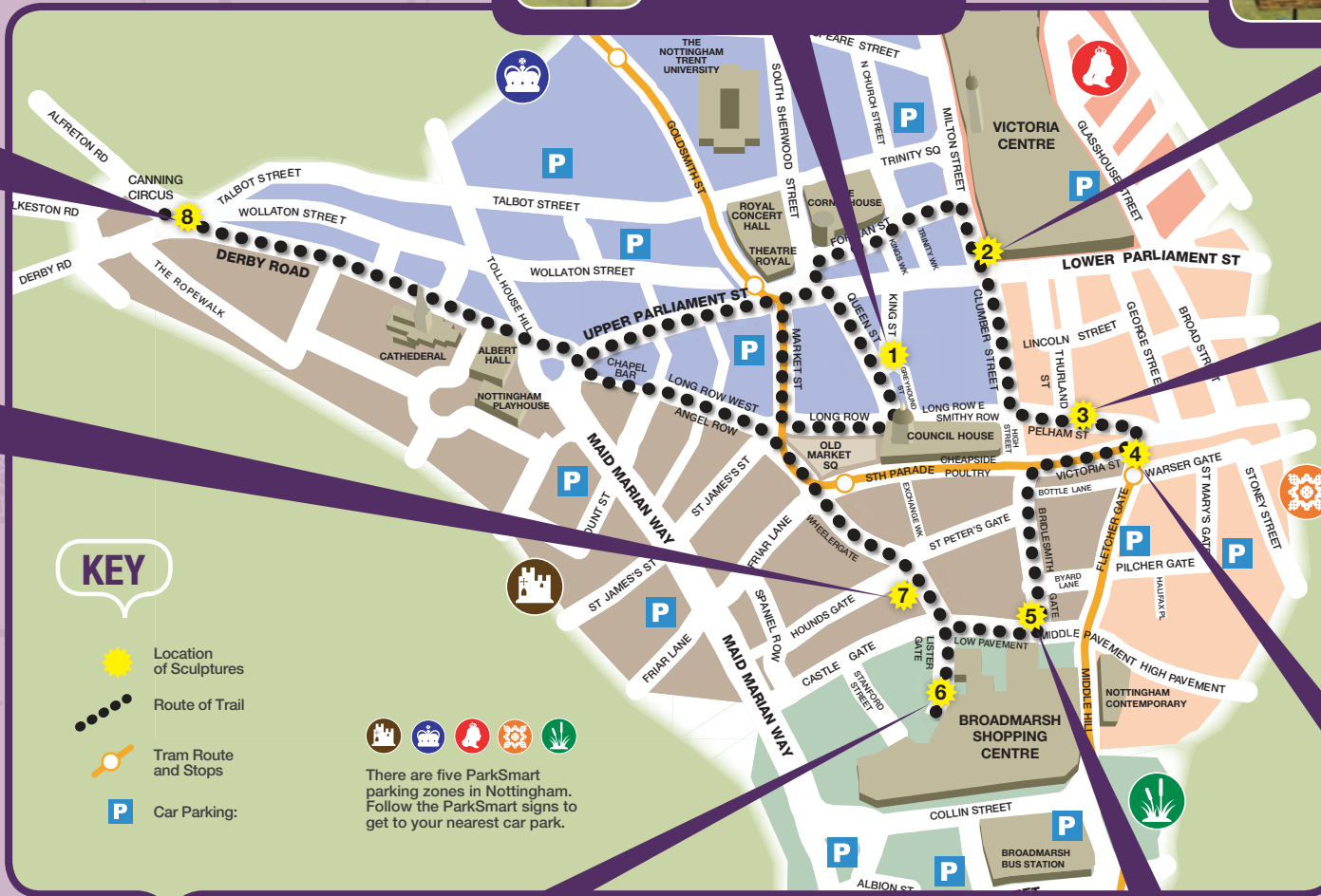
6. Handbag Listergate
